

Wheat Blanca Royale

Blanca Royale is a hard white wheat, and is most similar to the variety, Blanca Grande. The juvenile growth of Blanca Royale is semi-erect, and its plant color at boot stage is green. Its flag leaf is recurved, twisted, and is not waxy. Neither the auricles nor the stem have anthocyanin. Internodes are hollow, and the last internode of the rachis is hairy. Heads are awned, middense, tapering, and inclined. Anthers are yellow, and glumes are white. Seed of Blanca Royale is elliptical.

Taller variants have been observed at a frequency of 0.25% of the plant population. An awnless variant is present at a frequency of approximately 0.02%.
